National Hiatal Surgery Registry (NHSR) is a National Database used by Upper Gastrointestinal Surgeons in NHS and Private Healthcare to record anti-reflux operations, hiatal hernia repairs and cardiomyotomy procedures to treat Achalasia. The information in this database is stored in a secure server and protected under the new UK-GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation) and amended Data Protection Act 2018 Regulations. This information will allow surgeons and hospitals to reflect on their outcomes, compared to National Standards, through anonymised annual reports, by British Benign Upper GI Surgical Society (BBUGSS) and Association of Upper Gastrointestinal Surgeons (AUGIS) of Great Britain and Ireland.

This database will require surgeons to include details of the above operations they perform, the hospital numbers and date of birth of you as a patient. The reason for inclusion of your details is to ensure that this database can be used to track your progress and outcome of surgery. This registry will not use patient sensitive and recognisable data for research and scientific publications. The purpose of this registry is to improve patient care and by not participating it will not affect your care in any way.
